Activity: What You Will Get/What You Will Not Get

Objectives	Participants will be able to identify pictorially some services that resettlement agencies will provide within the first 30 days in the U.S.
Lesson Time	2-3 minutes

Practice	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Community Services<ol style="list-style-type: none">a. Participants review pictures.b. Trainer proceeds by asking:<ol style="list-style-type: none">i. Will the resettlement agency provide/assist with:ii. A computer?iii. A bed?iv. A car?v. Some food?vi. A stereo?vii. Shoes?viii. Registering children in school?ix. A large amount of cash?c. Participants collectively give verbal “yes/no” answers and “tick” or “cross” against the pictures as appropriate.2. Role of the resettlement agency<ol style="list-style-type: none">a. Ask participants to describe in their own words what it means to be self-sufficient.b. Participants look at the pictures. Ask participants to “tick” or “check” those items that their anchor or the resettlement agency will provide for them. Participants mark an “x” under those items not provided by their anchor or the resettlement agency.
