Activity: Resettlement Reality: Apartment Features

Introduction	This is a very “light” unit that will be much enjoyed by participants. If possible, leave it to the end of the day.
Objectives	By the end of this unit, participants will be able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Express expectations regarding housing that are realistic• Repeat factual information regarding housing• Solve a number of potential housing problems• Explain the uses of various kitchen and bathroom utilities• Explain various safety features and upkeep procedures
Time	30 – 45 minutes
Materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Model kitchen/bathroom• Pictures of furniture• Floor plan of apartment
Practice	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Divide participants into groups and give each group a set of furniture pictures and a floor plan of an apartment.2. Give participants 10-15 minutes to place the furniture into the room they think it belongs.3. Take participants on a tour of the kitchen and bathroom and show them the various features.4. If time allows, let some participants try out the stove, etc.
